	We require students applying for an exchange period at RWTH Aachen University to have at least B1.1 level of German knowledge in the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). Please note that students not meeting our language requirements may not be accepted as exchange students. 	Students taking English-taught courses exclusively are required to attach a B1 certificate of ENGLISH (6.0 IELTS) and do not need to proof their German skills (although prior knowledge is highly recommended!).
