Application

After nomination by you, your students will receive an email containing a detailed description of the application process and required documents. The students shall then register online and upload their documents. After checking all documents, we will issue an invitation letter for exchange studies at TU Ilmenau.

Courses

The general language of instruction at Technische Universität Ilmenau is German. All Bachelor programs are therefore (mainly) taught in German. Nevertheless, we are offering six English Master programs:

- Communications and Signal Processing
- International Business Economics
- Media and Communication Science
- Media Technology
- Micro- and Nanotechnologies
- Research in Computer and Systems Engineering

Please kindly note that some courses take place only in either winter or summer semester. To discuss their personal schedule in the framework of their Learning Agreements, all students are obliged to get in contact with the examination office of their department. We will send them information on this, including contact details.

Language requirements

Depending on the chosen courses, your students have to prove their proficiency in either German or English by means of a certificate. The minimum level for admission at TU Ilmenau is level B1 (CEFR).

Costs of living

It is advisable to have a budget of 934.00 euros per month (for food and accommodation, travelling expenses, studying material and social activities).

All students are required to pay a semester contribution (“Semesterbeitrag”) for the constituted student body (including a ticket for the free usage of local trains within the Free State of Thuringia) as follows:

First semester: 147.00 euros; from second semester onwards: 132.00 euros

Accommodation

All students who have received an invitation letter may apply for a dorm room on the campus. The link to the online application is stated in the invitation letter. These rooms are offered by the Studierendenwerk Thüringen. The monthly costs are between 171.00 and 295.00 euros.

Health insurance

All students are required by law to have a valid and sufficient health insurance. Either your students need to have a European health insurance that is valid here, too, or they have to conclude one for their stay at TU Ilmenau. They can contact me for further information.

All students who send us their arrival details will be picked up from Ilmenau train station. Our team of tutors will help them with all administrative processes right from the start until their last day of stay.

Within the first days after their arrival, the students will be introduced to Technische Universität Ilmenau, its courses, schedule, facilities on the campus, student life and much more.
