

## CHINA



The University of Toulouse is home to top-ranking research centres covering all areas of sciences and technology, the humanities and social sciences with 15 doctoral schools. The International PhD Office of the University of Toulouse is in charge of identifying and organizing the supply of PhD thesis proposals, within framework programs with some countries. The University of Toulouse has a strong commitment to **China**, reinforced by the agreement signed between our University and the China Scholarship Council (CSC) in 2011. With **more than 1,500 Chinese students and 195 PhD candidates**, Chinese students are the largest international population at the University of Toulouse. The International PhD Office tends going every year to China to meet Master students that wish to do a PhD in Toulouse.

## **CSC PROGRAM**

The China Scholarship Council (CSC) provides PhD scholarships to Chinese candidates who wish to be enrolled in the University of Toulouse.

## SELECTION PROCEDURE AGENDA

- ✓ November 22nd, 2021 : open call for applications
- ✓ Until February 13th, 2022 : deadline for Chinese students to Apply into the international thesis database of the University of Toulouse : <a href="https://doctorat.univ-toulouse.fr/banque-internationale-de-sujets?ed=&pays=Chine&site=EDT">https://doctorat.univ-toulouse.fr/banque-internationale-de-sujets?ed=&pays=Chine&site=EDT</a>
- ✓ February 16th to February 28th, 2022 : selection by a PhD admission board in the University of Toulouse and results of the selection process by the University of Toulouse
- ✓ March 10th to March 31th 2022 : complete the application online on the CSC's website for the selected candidates
- ✓ April 2022 : evaluation of the applications by the CSC and final selection
- ✓ May, 2022 : candidates are informed of the results of the application to the CSC's scholarship
- ✓ August-October 2022 : PhD Students join their research groups and enroll in their Doctoral Schools

## LEVEL REQUIRED TO APPLY TO THE CSC

All theses can be **fully written in English**. A minimum level of English proficiency is required for all applicants:

- TOEIC : 700 - TOEFL : 95 - IELTS : 6.5

**HOW TO APPLY** 



1. Browse the list of thesis proposals in the website dedicated : http://www.adum.fr/as/ed/sujetInternatio.pl?ed=&pays=Chine

**If you find a thesis proposal** that matches with the research you expect to do for your PhD, apply directly on the website.

**If you don't find** an interesting thesis proposal on the list, the International PhD Office can help you to find a supervisor in a research center.

- Send a CV and a short application letter including a brief description of your research background to: phd-international@univ-toulouse.fr
- 2. After an interview (e.g. Skype), the French supervisor may provide you an **invitation letter** to accept your application. This invitation is an internal document (in French) for the doctoral school and University of Toulouse, **not for the CSC**.
- 3. Send your application file to <a href="mailto:phd-international@univ-toulouse.fr">phd-international@univ-toulouse.fr</a> before February 13th, 2022 containing all of the following documents in ONLY ONE PDF attached file (Give imperatively the following file name to the document: yourlastname your firstname your birthdate.pdf):
  - The **thesis proposal description**: title, thesis supervisor, short description of the subject, Doctoral school, laboratory.
  - **PhD goals and motivation**: explain why you applied for this thesis proposal, Research Methods you plan to use, Schedule you plan to follow for your PhD
  - Invitation letter from the French supervisor for the admission board (in french)
  - Curriculum Vitae
  - Scan of your **ID card**
  - All diplomas and degrees certificates
  - All transcripts (in English) from undergraduate studies to the Master degree
  - The **English or French language proficiency certificate** (mandatory)
  - The pdf file should not exceed 2Mo, if it is too big you may scan your documents in a lower resolution
- 4. From February 16th to 28th, 2022, selected candidates will receive the **official invitation** from the International PhD Office.
- 5. With the official invitation letter you follow the application process to apply to China Scholarship Council scholarship program. The selected candidates must apply online on CSC's website between 10th to March 31th 2022.
