at a glance

Language course

The language courses are offered at levels ranging from A2 to C1. A placement test must be submitted prior to beginning the course. The final course placement will occur upon arrival.

Participants receive at least 4 course hours of instruction each day. In the courses students will expand their knowledge of German grammar and vocabulary. Oral expression, listening comprehension, and reading and writing skills will be intensively trained using authentic material. The language of instruction is German.



In addition, participants can attend workshops in the afternoon on a variety of topics including writing, literature, phonetics, musik, architecture, media, theater, Europe, etc.

Course material is included in the course fee.

The maximum number of participants per course is 15.

Cultural and social activities

In addition to the language program, students also have the opportunity to participate in a culture and leisure program and to visit important sights.

The course price includes:

- opening & closing event
- a city tour
- sightseeing in and around Aachen
- museum visits
- movie nights



Other activities (sports events, picnics, barbecues, concerts, etc.) will also be organised (additional costs may be incurred).

Excursions

Participants especially interested in German life and culture and who wish to improve their practical language skills may sign up for our excursions.



Each excursion is devoted to a specific topic and will be accompanied by our language instructors. Some examples from previous years include Bonn (Modern German History), Essen (Industry and Business), Cologne (History of Art), Maastricht and Brussels (Europe) or Monschau in the Eifel (Rural Germany).



These excursions must be booked separately. You will receive further information after registering. There are only a limited number of places available for the excursions. Only RWTH Summer School participants are eligible.

Accommodation

The RWTH Summer School is able to provide a limited number of single rooms in student residences. These rooms have to be booked and paid for when registering for the language course.

The rooms vary somewhat from residence to residence, but all have access to a bath/shower, kitchen and usually a washing machine. The rooms cost 270 EUR for the duration of your stay.

Allocation of the rooms is done centrally: it is not possible to book rooms in specific residences.
