

Letter of Invitation

On behalf of the KAIST students and faculty, we invite you to an upcoming online conference **PIONEERS 2071: Questioning the Next 50 Years**.

The purpose of the conference is to provide undergraduate students with the opportunity to explore potential global crises that may happen over the next 50 years and propose possible solutions with policies, technology, and innovative ideas.

We will present three scenarios of potential crises as follows, and applicants will choose one topic they would like to explore:

Division 1: Environment: Pollution and Climate Change

Division 2: The Next Outbreak: Pandemic **Division 3:** Education, Economics, and AI

Applicants form a group of four to eight participants and register as a team. Each team must come up with original ideology, policies, and innovative ideas to resolve the issues described in the scenario in preparation for the conference. At the conference, teams present their ideas and debate how each other's proposals may or may not be effective in resolving the crisis and making the world a better place.

Awards and Prizes

The winners of each division are given the following awards:

Grand Award (Top 1 team): \$3000

Gold (2 teams): \$2000

The second-place winners of each division are given the silver award:

Silver (3 teams): \$1000

Conference Dates: Feb 2–7, 2021 (GMT+9)


