(within the first three workdays after your arrival) Every citizen / student has to register at the Registration Office of Innsbruck. For this you should download the document "Meldezettel". After you filled in the form you need to get a signature from your landlord or student home. Please take this document together with your passport to the following office:

2. Registration at the University of Innsbruck

a.) You go to the University Admission Department (Studienabteilung) on the ground floor of the main building, Room 0105A (Monday – Friday 8.00-12.00 and Tuesday, Wednesday 13.30-15.30) with the Letter of Admission "Mitteilung" from Innsbruck University (which was sent to you by e-mail and postal mail).

b) You fill in the Meldungsblatt. You receive a pay-in slip for the compulsory Students Union membership of € 18. After that you receive an e-mail account with a user name and password for LFU:online (LFU is the abbreviation for Leopold-Franzens Universität).

c) You are photographed for the student ID-card. You pay the membership using your cash card at one of the service points in the university buildings. You can also pay the

membership by using the pay slip. Once your student ID-card is activated you can print your "Studienbestätigung" (proof of registration) using LFU:online
